## **Matters Arising From Action Points**

- Said service is due to happen soon, and afterwards, BA will sit down with DH to finalise the paperwork before posting off to Calor Gas

  - repairs to the boiler room (see Building Work)

  - > a patch for the trapdoor in the West End exit

# **Building Work**

External and Internal Paintwork

- The painting of the external windows has been started by Cockburn's, but progress is still being held back by the weather
- In the meanwhile, repairs to the internal damp patch are in train and have shown up other problems with some plasterwork on the ceiling
- Both the original damp patch and the new ceiling hole have now been patched up, and will be re-painted when dry

#### West End Door

- Barry Rollo has been instructed to proceed with work on the West End Door, and he has promised to start as soon as he can
- Moreover, he has already provided an invoice so that we can approach GMCC for Local Priorities Fund funding before the closing date at the end of the month
- ACTION: HC

#### Path Across Orchard

- Community Service have been asked to install a membrane covered with slate chippings so to prevent weed growth on the strip of land between the new path and the building
- We still await to hear from them when it will be done

#### **Boiler Room**

- HC and KM have now cleared out the Boiler Room, and done some remedial plastering
- They reported that there are serious problems with the old fireplace however, namely rotten wood and "stuff" coming down the chimney, which need professional attention
- As such, it was decided that Barry Rollo should be asked to have a look when he next attends the West Exit Door and be asked to quote for a cowl and boarding up the hearth
