- Potential re varnishing of the floors to be undertaken, GM to speak with EM and take potential quotes.
- Crack in the wall by kitchen, needs attention and the roof above needs to be checked and surveyed, SE to source and potentially arange quotes.
- PW from GMCC to organise a generator for the hall, to provide heating and electricity to the village in the event of prolonged power cuts, GVHT fully backs the idea and supports the hall to house the generator.
- GM to engage with energy efficiency Scotland on way the hall could be more green.
- Blinds for the windows have been suggested but potentially down the priority list of what money needs to be spent on.
