PRIVACY NOTICE

How to withdraw your data: If you no longer wish your data to be held for this purpose, please get in touch – see below.

What if your data becomes 'at risk'?: Should your data become 'at risk' (for example, lost or stolen) we will determine the level of risk to the security of your data, and determine whether to report the breach to yourself and/or the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO).
